Proceedings of the meeting of the Motor Vehicle Board held on 3.11.2020 at 10.00 AM under the Chairpersonship of Chief Secretary, Punjab in the Committee Room at 6th Floor, Main Secretariat.

The issue regarding the entitlement of vehicles fixed for various posts in the previous meetings of Motor Vehicle Board (MVB) was discussed and it was observed that the expenditure incurred on purchase of vehicles should be curtailed. Secondly, whenever the vehicle manufacturers discard the old models and bring new models, MVB is required to approve the new models. To address these twin issues, information gathered by the transport department regarding various vehicles available in the market and their price range, was examined and it was felt that variety of vehicles are available in all the price ranges to suit the functional requirement of various departments. The pattern followed by Government of India is also examined in detail. Accordingly, it was decided that for future purchases the entitlement of vehicles for officers/officials of all the departments shall be categorised in TWO groups.

Group 1: Vehicles in price range of Rs. 5 Lac to Rs. 8 Lac and;

Group 2: Vehicles in price range of Rs. 8 Lac to Rs. 12 Lac.

Deputy Commissioners, Senior Superintendent of Police (SSP) of police district, Divisional Commissioners, range DIGs, police commissioners, IGs, Additional Director General of Police (ADGP), Head of the Departments and above are entitled to vehicles of Group 2.

All the remaining eligible officers shall fall in the category of Group 1.

The following would be strictly observed while purchasing the new vehicle.

1. The departments are free to choose a particular vehicle depending upon their requirement within the limits of the Group price range mentioned above.
2. The vehicles shall be purchased through GeM portal only. However if the vehicle is not available on GeM portal it shall be purchased directly from the manufacturer.
3. Preference should be given to EV/CNG/Petrol vehicles.
4. All the existing entitlements stand modified to this extent except for any special purpose vehicles and for any clarification; the issue may be referred to MVB for appropriate decision.
5. The aforementioned prices are GeM prices/ex-show room prices.

It was decided that purchase of vehicles should ordinarily be avoided and hiring be done instead. All the future provisioning of vehicles for newly created posts henceforth would only be on hiring basis unless otherwise mentioned explicitly. Resultantly any available driver post be considered for transfer to Transport department. It was also decided that the transport department should float a tender to fix hiring charges for various vehicles to be used by departments which would be finalized and circulated to all the departments.

It was clarified that the issue of vehicles for Raj Bhawan, Chief Minister office, Ministers, MPs, MLAs, Chairpersons, High Court Judges shall not be governed by the above categorization, it shall continue as per existing system.

Then individual agendas were deliberated upon and decisions were taken as follow:

Agenda No. 1


Ex-post factor approval of Vehicles for the Punjab Raj Bhawan, Chandigarh

Ex-post facto approval was accorded. Approval for the purchase of another vehicle as per Group 2 in place of Jeep Compass Sports 4x2 (2.0 Diesel)-1 is also granted.

Agenda No. 2

Replacement of Vehicles attached with Sub-Divisional Magistrate.

It was approved that the vehicles for Sub-Divisional Magistrates shall be from Group 1 (Price range of Rs.5Lac to Rs.8 Lac.)



Agenda No. 3**Provision of Vehicles for Water Resources Department**

It was decided that the department should review its demand and submit a revised proposal in the next meeting.

Agenda No. 4**Fixation of Fuel norms of vehicles attached with Judicial Officers.**

It was decided that the life norm of Swift DzireVXi and LXi (Petrol) vehicles attached with Judicial Officers shall be 4 lakhs kilometer or 10 years, whichever is earlier. It was further decided to extend this norm to all the Government vehicles (petrol) attached with officers in view of the improved road conditions and improved technology in the vehicle manufacturing.


Agenda No. 5**Government Vehicles, which have completed their life norms.**

It was decided to authorize the Head of Departments to take a decision to continue the use of vehicles even after they complete the norms fixed by MVB, depending upon its condition and intended use on year-to-year basis, till validity of the registration certificate of the vehicle.

Agenda No. 6**To increase the fleet strength and ex-post facto approval for the vehicles of Police Department.**

While deliberating on the proposal it was informed by the department that Gol has already released Rs.1 Cr. for purchase of vehicles and that for the remaining Rs.2 Cr. there was provision in the budget allocation. After detailed discussions approval for 14 MarutiErtiga (AC) vehicles with upper ceiling limit of Rs.1 Cr. was granted. This is a one-time sanction for the funds from Government of India and wouldn't be the basis for seeking funds from Finance for future replacement.

Ex-post facto approval of 5 armored vehicles already purchased in addition to 27 already approved by MVB in its meeting held on 13/1/2016 was granted.



Agenda No.7**Ex-post facto approval of vehicles used for the security of Chief Minister, Punjab**

Ex-post facto approval for the change in the make of vehicles used for the security of Chief Minister, Punjab was granted.

Agenda No. 8**To fix the life norms of vehicles which are on duty for the Protection of Chief Minister, Punjab**

Approval was granted for the following life norms of the vehicles which are on duty for the Protection of Chief Minister, Punjab:-

Sr. No.	Type of vehicle	Proposed Life Norm

4	Bullet Proof Mitsubishi Montero	2.50 Lakh Kilometer or 07 Years
5	Non B.P. Mitsubishi Montero	4 Lakh Kilometer or 07 Years
6	Tata Safari Jammers	2 Lakh Kilometer or 05 Years


It was further decided that after attaining the life norm fixed above, these vehicles shall be transferred to the Police Department for re-deployment/disposal.

Agenda 9**Provision of vehicles for Special Secretary/Addl. Secretary**

It was decided that the General Administration Department would review the proposal and submit a revised proposal in the next meeting.

Agenda 10**To fix the Fuel Mileage of Vehicles of Police Department**

The issue is directly affecting the expenditure of departments across the spectrum. After detailed discussion and keeping in view of the recommendation of the technical committee set up by police department, it was decided that a uniform guiding principle of up-to 20% less, and 30% less, than the mileage claimed by the manufactures for a particular vehicle aged less than 5 yrs, and 5yrs to 10yrs respectively, be followed to fix the mileage.



As recommended by the department and based on the above guiding principle, fuel mileage of vehicles mentioned at Sr. No. 1 to 4, 6, 8, 11, 13, 14, 16 to 18, 21 to 23, 26 to 33 is hereby approved as proposed in the agenda. Regarding the vehicles mentioned at Sr. No. 5, 7, 9, 12, 15, 25, the fuel mileage is fixed as 16.8, 11.10, 10.7, 10.4, 9.8, 6.3 respectively.

It was further decided that for the vehicles mentioned at Sr. No. 10, 19, 20, 24 and 34, Transport Department and Police Department will form a joint committee to recommend the fuel mileage of these vehicles depending on their use and condition.

Agenda 11

Revision of fleet strength of Vehicles of Punjab Bhawan, New Delhi

In view of the principle laid down in the beginning, it was decided that Punjab Bhawan should hire vehicles as per requirement from time to time.

Agenda 12

Revision of fleet strength of vehicles of Department of Welfare

Approval was given to increase the fleet strength of Vehicles from 20 to 22 of the Department of Welfare and the same shall fall within Group 1. The vehicles shall be provisioned on hiring basis.

Agenda 13

To re-fix the price of InnovaCrysta (2.4L) GX7 vehicles entitled to Divisional Commissioner and Deputy Commissioners

It was decided that the vehicles for the Commissioner's, Deputy Commissioner's shall be in the Group 2 in the price range Rs. 8 to Rs. 12 lakhs.

Agenda 14

To fix the fleet strength of vehicles for the Punjab Bureau of Investigation (28 SP & 108 DSPs)

It was decided that the Punjab Bureau of Investigation shall re-examine the proposal and revised proposal be put up in the next meeting.



Agenda 15**To fix the average of different types of vehicles run with Punjab Government Departments.**

The fuel mileage of the vehicles being less than 5 years old be fixed by the department based on the guiding principles mentioned while dealing with agenda item No 8.

Agenda 16**Replacement of Vehicles of Department of Agriculture (Soil and Water Conservation)**

The proposal at Sr. No. 2 and 3 of the agenda for change of make and type of vehicle is approved as per Group 1. Proposal mentioned in the agenda at Sr No. 4, 5, 6 and 7 for change in type/make of vehicle is approved as proposed by the department being special purpose vehicles.

Agenda 17**Revision of vehicle of Chairman, Punjab State Commission for NRI**


It was intimated that as per the terms and conditions of appointment of Chairman, NRI, the Chairman is to be provided vehicle as per entitlement of a High Court Judge. Accordingly, the entitlement of Toyota InnovaCrysta Diesel (VX2.4 Model) 8 seater instead of Toyota Corola 1.8G Altis was approved.

Agenda 18**Revision of fleet strength of 120 Motor Cycles gifted by M/s Honda Motor Cycles & Scooter India Pvt. Ltd to Police Department.**

The request to increase the fleet strength of 120 Motor Cycles was approved. This increase in fleet strength is specific to 120 motorcycles given as gift by Honda Company to Punjab Police hence the same would expire on condemnation of these motorcycles.

Agenda 19**Entitlement of vehicles for the Chief Information Commissioner, Information Commissioners and Secretary, Punjab Information Commission.**

AD clarified that Chief Information Commissioner does not need a vehicle presently. It was decided that the members of the Information Commission are entitled to vehicles in the Group 2 i.e. in the price range of Rs.8 to Rs 12 Lakhs and Secretary as Level 1 i.e. Rs. 5 to Rs. 8 Lakhs. Vehicles shall be taken on hire at the rates to be fixed by the transport department.



Agenda 20**Ex-post facto approval of vehicles of Jail Department**

In light of the position explained by the Police Department in the meeting, Motor Vehicle Board approves the following corrected total fleet strength of the Department of Jails:-

Supplementary Agenda 1**Revision of fleet strength of Excise & Taxation Department.**

During the meeting, Excise & Taxation Department explained in the meeting that the Excise and Taxation department has been divided into 2 departments (Punjab Tax Commissionerate and Punjab Excise Commissionerate). This is why the fleet strength of vehicles has to be increased from the existing fleet strength of 158 to 199.

The Board approved the vehicles in the Group 2 i.e. range of price 8 to 12 lakhs for the Commissioner and Group 1 for the Joint Excise & Taxation Commissioner (02), Dy Excise & Taxation Commissioner (04), Asstt. Excise Commissioner (10) and Asstt. Excise Commissioner (Mobile Wings) (24) on hiring basis.


Supplementary Agenda 2

Revision of fleet strength of vehicles used for the Protection of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab (Special Protection Unit)

Home Department during the meeting explained that the Special Protection Unit has intimated that in view of the current scenario and security requirement/threat perception to the life of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab and his family members, fleet of the vehicles is required to be revised from 113 to 169 vehicles.

The Board approved to revise the fleet strength of vehicles used for the protection of Hon'ble Chief Minister, Punjab (Special Protection Unit) as under: -
